Why do we need your help?

- Litter is unsightly - it destroys the aesthetics of our beautiful parks and City
- Litter is expensive – we hire seasonal workers to pick up litter and empty trashcans for five months each year and still we cannot keep up with the problem
- Your help each spring, summer, and fall will save tax dollars and allow maintenance workers to devote time and effort to other important projects
- Spring Litter pick up must be done prior to spring mowing by Public Works staff.
- A litter free community is inviting to visitors, prospective new citizens, and businesses

What are the adopter's responsibilities?

- Begin street right-a-way litter pick up in spring (March-April). Throughout the summer and fall maintain the adopted area on a monthly basis.
- Do not attempt to remove homeless sites or suspected toxic/hazardous substances, needles, sharp objects or objects too heavy or large to move – note approximate location on the map and notify Public Works.
- Leave filled garbage bags along street boulevards for pick up by Public Works.

- Schedule your pick up time to get safety vests, garbage bags, trash pickup tools, and disposable gloves.
- Call when clean-up is completed so staff can promptly pick up garbage bags the following day.
