



## The following guidelines will be followed at both Moorhead golf courses to help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Club houses will be open; one customer will be allowed at a time. Credit/debit cards will be the only payment option available. Cash/check will not be accepted.
- Customers are encouraged to schedule tee times over the phone (218.299.PUTT) or online at [moorheadgolf.com](http://moorheadgolf.com). Season passes are available for purchase online as well. Tee time intervals will be scheduled 14 minutes apart. Tee times are limited to groups of four or less. Please check in 5 minutes prior to your tee time.
- Practice facilities including putting greens and practice bunkers are now open to the public.
- Driving ranges will be open during this time. Range balls will be sold in pre-filled, sanitized buckets, located on a table next to driving range shed. Empty buckets can be left at the hitting station and staff will collect and sanitize. If all stations are full, please wait patiently for the next available spot while practicing social distancing guidelines.
- Golf carts will be allowed on the course, one cart per person, unless you live within the same household. Each cart is sanitized after each use.
- Courses will temporarily suspend the use of water jugs, bunker rakes, and ball washers.
- Flagsticks will remain in the cup hole. Raised cups will be implemented for safe golf ball retrieval. Please abstain from retrieving stray golf balls and sharing golf clubs.
- Rest rooms will be open and available for customers. Sanitation will occur twice daily. Customers are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- Full food and beverage services are temporarily suspended. Courses will offer non-alcoholic beverages and “grab and go” food options during this time. No alcohol will be served and personal coolers will not be allowed on courses.
- There will be no tournaments or social gatherings at the course until further notice. The course will continue to book future events, but of a tentative nature.
- Please practice tolerance and respect for course rules, staff, and other golfers. Failure to follow these rules may result in immediate removal from the course without a refund.

These guidelines have been created through the support of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local health officials. We are continuing to monitor the impact of COVID-19 as it relates to our golf course operations which could lead to altering or ceasing operations at any time. We appreciate your cooperation during this unusual time and are excited to provide you with this recreation opportunity once again.
