FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why has this study been initiated?

Have you ever been stuck waiting for a train in downtown Moorhead? How about consecutive trains? If you have, you understand how frustrating this can be. The purpose of this study is to identify potential alignments for a railroad grade separation (underpass) in downtown.

Why should I attend?

You may have attended meetings for previous studies pertaining to traffic issues in downtown Moorhead. The intent of this study is to prepare a project to seek funding for construction of an underpass in downtown Moorhead. This study builds upon past recommendations and analysis by carrying forward underpass alternatives previously determined to be feasible. The current study will evaluate, prioritize and select a planning level alternative for an underpass.

The meeting will cover the existing deficiencies related to downtown train activity and discuss the current range of alternatives. This meeting provides an opportunity to voice your opinion regarding issues related to a potential underpass in downtown Moorhead.
