# BUSINESS RECYCLING CHECKLIST



A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE FOR STARTING A RECYCLING PROGRAM AT YOUR PLACE OF WORK

#### **1. ASSESS YOUR CURRENT SITUATION**

Look at where your current trash containers are located, how many there are, and look at what is in them. Estimate how much of their contents are recyclable material, such as plastic, glass, metal, paper, and cardboard. Fill out the worksheet below to help you in step 2.

#### **5. SET UP YOUR PROGRAM**

Place a recycling bin next to each garbage canister in your workplace for the best results, and make sure that there are recycling bins in high-traffic areas. Clearly label each bin with our "Always/Never in the Bin" guide, or order stickers for your canisters by contacting our sustainability manager at {218-XXX-XXXX}.
